Those Council Members present were: Mr. Danny Medlin, Mr. Eugene Brown, Paul Barber, Stormie Combs, and Richard Lattier


Agenda Item One: Budget Workshop

Each council member looked over the proposed budget for 2024-2025. It was brought to attention that we should raise the answering service amount at least 200.00 more to make close to what this year has been spent. The road and maintenance needed to raise a lot more due to roads needing to be fixed. A question was raised asking what the miscellaneous was with a 2000.00 amount. Stormie asked who was and what was the part time officer and let her know that it was proposed for the next year we do not have one at this time. It would increase the revenue for the police department and help with patrol. It was agreed on not getting a part time officer at this time. The payroll for the chief was asked about and he let them know he has not asked for a raise in two years. Richard said could give the raise and not hire anyone else at this time. That the department needs to get more functional. With hiring a new judge the pay amount would have to double to 6000.00 a year. Eugene mentioned that we do not need to show the water refundable deposit and the water deposit refunds since this was money that was untouchable to use for anything else. Could only count the non-refundable deposit. We will look over again at the next meeting and see if any more changes need to be made. Kevin gave several pointers on each item discussed
