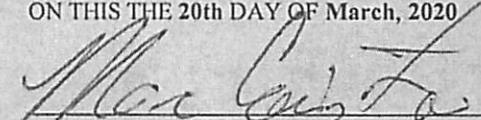

Agenda Item Three, Discuss and Vote on Future Council meetings:

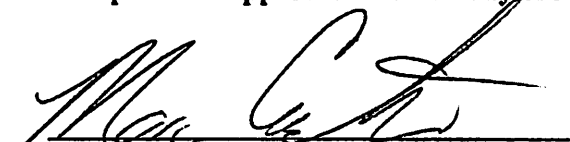
