

**Agenda Item One, Discuss Land Purchase, Mayor Marc Covington**

Mayor Marc Covington discussed land that had been found to purchase.

2.25 acres with building on it, FM 1844 and Gilmer Rd, Mr. James Vises has agreed to sell land for the amount of \$350,000.00

Building could be used for pump station, and would be closer to tying into Longview Water. Jason has agreed to purchase a portion of the land for his use at the Game Room.

Mr. Billy Morrow suggested that we get survey of the land.

Mr. Eugene Brown made a motion to have land surveyed and make earnest money payment to move forward and Mr. Danny Medlin seconded. The vote was unanimous to proceed then to vote again.

**Agenda Item Two, Discuss Purchase of New Police Car, Mayor Marc Covington**
